High school students from Delaware County can register to represent the young leaders in our community during the Delaware County America 250 celebrations during the calendar year of 2025 & 2026. High School Students in Delaware County are all eligible for this program throughout 2025 & 2026. Student Ambassadors will be expected to have an understanding of the American Foundation in 1776. We aim to be inclusive to promote knowledge of ALL leaders, not only the men who signed the Declaration of Independence as well as movements toward the independence of ALL people throughout American history. Students will be encouraged to relate our past independence to their own new independence as graduates moving forward into the next generation of leadership. Students will receive a cord of distinction identifying them as a Delaware County Historical Society America 250 Student Ambassador. Students may also be encouraged to participate in America 250 celebrations in their school and community events surrounding the celebration of America 250 if they choose.

**Each student will complete a minimum of 10 volunteer hours within the Delaware County History Network museums and community programs.*

**Student Ambassadors will complete time with 4 classes taught by local historians related to the founding documents.*
